Dear Parents and Guardians,

In Term 4, 2021 we issued an invitation to consider whether your child or children are ready to participate in the Sacramental Program of Preparation for Reconciliation, Confirmation and First Eucharist in 2022. As the important Parent Information Evening looms closer, I wanted to extend a final invitation for anyone who might not have yet had the chance to contact the parish office to register their child for the Sacramental Program 2022.

Just a reminder that the one and only Parent Information Evening for the entire program will be held: Thursday 10th February, 7:00pm at Corpus Christi Church. The evening will cover all three Sacraments and outline the structure and other important information for our hands-on, interactive and engaging program that I am confident you will find a positive and meaningful experience.

In 2022, the proposed preparation program will include First Reconciliation (Confession) in Term 1, Confirmation in Term 2, and First Eucharist (First Holy Communion) in Term 3. Generally, we aim the Sacraments at Grade 4 level, but due to covid and other circumstances, some children may have missed the program in the last year or two. All children in Grade 4 and above are very welcome to participate, as the program is adaptable to older ages as well.
