Grade 1

In Maths, we have been learning to skip count by 5's. We have had lots of fun singing songs, creating towers, giving each other 'paper high fives' and painting.



Grade 2

In Grade 2, the students have been learning about place value. They have learnt about ones, tens, hundreds and some students even challenged with thousands. Below these students were asked to create a 2-digit number using dice then model the number using base 10 blocks.









Grade 4

Following on from last week, Grade 4 tested their Ski Jump designs. Using a marble, we tested the distance it travelled once released. Students had a lot of fun creating and designing their ski jump. We then discussed how we could improve the design, what worked well and if they made any modifications to their original plan. We have some budding engineers in Grade 4!!



Grade 5

In Grade 5 we have been looking at the Elements of Drama, working with a specific focus of developing Character and Voice. Students have been exploring exactly what each of these elements involves and using their new understanding in performances of Jack and The Beanstalk.



Grade 6

This week in Grade 6 we created a new play area for all students. The 8-square lines have been painted as another play space for all students.
